- Make me a medic (MMAM) was devised as a way to increase cross site and collaborative working
- Involves both undergraduate and postgraduate teams
- Designed to provide an experience to sixth form students interested in a career in medicine

Who we reach

- We prioritise students from schools in our local catchment area
- We are proud to encourage widening participation and so target schools with high proportions of free school meals
- Through collaboration with In2MedSchool, project was expanded to a national audience

Who attended

- A total of 114 students registered over 3 days
- 76.9% identified as female
- All were aged between 16 and 17
- From over 50 different education institutions



What did we do?

- We ran a variety of sessions covering application to first steps on successful entry
- Practical workshops covering ethics and basic clinical skills
- Specialty fair giving insights into potential career options
- MDT roundtable to give insights into wider healthcare careers








