The narrow road: Leading International Graduates(IMGs) through to the Door of Runthrough Paediatric Training

Background

UK Paediatric training is very competitive. We aimed to support International Medical Graduates (IMGs) to achieve training offers.


Methodology

- Between September 2022 to April 2023, a faculty of IMG Paediatric Consultants and Postgraduate Doctors in Training provided targeted support to IMGs applying for UK Paediatric training.
- An applications evening, peer mentoring, peer and consultant review of applications, and mock interviews were arranged.
- Participation throughout the process was tracked.
- Feedback via anonymized online survey were collected following offers.

Results

- 114 applications from 60 applicants.
- Of these, 30 ST1/2 and 16 ST3/4 interview preparations were supported.
- 23 (76.6%) got ST1/2 offers.
- 14 (87.5%) got ST3/4 offers.
- Overall, 80.4% of our cohort's shortlisted applications got offers.
- 48 applicants responded to our survey.
- Of the 32 (66.7%) survey respondents who were first-attempts; 69% got offers.
- 40% of overseas applicants got offers, compared to 76% of UKbased applicants.
- 98% of responding candidates reported finding the process useful.

What area of the IMG targeted support did the participants find most useful



Take home messages

- High shortlisting attrition rate may indicate differential attainment from prior curriculum exposure.
- As the pre-interview approach shows, targeted pre-application support could lead to significant candidate success.
